

This is for general information of the public that distribution of APL, BPL, AAY & Special Adhoc/Additional quota of APL Rice, Levy Sugar and S.K.Oil are being made available to all F.P. Shop centers against December, 2011 quota. Date of issue of Rice from the following Wholesale Centers are as below:

- 1). 31st, January, 2012 :- Ummulong Wholesale Centres
- 2). 1<sup>st</sup>, Febuary, 2012 :- Shangpung Wholesale Centres.
- 3). 2<sup>nd</sup>, Febuary, 2012 :- Nartiang & Jowai Wholesale Centres.

**Scale & Rate of Issue to Consumers as follows:-**

1. Above Poverty Line (APL) quota of Rice at the scale of 15.130 per family per month for both Rural and Urban areas. Selling rate fixed at Urban areas is Rs.9.70 per Kg while in Rural areas the selling rate is at the rate fixed for their respective centre.
2. Special Adhoc / Additional APL quota of Rice at the scale of 8.905 kgs per APL family per month for both Rural and Urban areas. Selling rate fixed at Urban areas is Rs.9.70 per Kg while in Rural areas the selling rate is at the rate fixed for their respective centre.
3. Below Poverty Line (BPL) quota of rice at the scale of 35 Kgs per BPL F.I. Card and at the rate of Rs. 6.15 per Kg for both Rural and Town areas.
4. Antyodaya Anna Yojna (AAY) quota of rice at the scale of 35 Kgs per AAY F.I. Card at the rate of Rs. 3.00 per Kg for both Rural and Town areas.
5. Levy Sugar at the scale of 600 grams per head per month for both Town and Rural areas. Selling rate fixed at Urban areas is Rs.14.21 per Kg while in Rural areas the selling rate is at the rate fixed for their respective centre.
6. S.K.Oil (January/12 Quota) at the scale of 6.5 litres per F.I. Card in Town areas at the rate of Rs.16.41 per litres. In rural areas at the scale of 3.5 litres per family per month at the rate fixed for their respective centres/villages
